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Dear Parents and Guardians,

Each year, Haddon Township administers a number of standardized assessments throughout the school year. They vary in their scope and purpose, and are given to students in a range of grades, depending on the nature of the assessment and the needs of the district. Some of these assessments are required by State or Federal law, and others, such as the PSAT/NMSQT are provided by private entities to provide critical data to the district's schools.

New Jersey State law requires that each school district provide parents general information about the standardized assessments administered over the course of the year, including testing windows, the duration of the assessment, the subjects and grades to be assessed, and the approximate time when score reports become available.

Attached to this memorandum is a grid that provides this information for standardized assessments administered in Haddon Township. Please be aware that the information provided applies to most students in most situations; however, some students may be exempt from testing or eligible for alternative assessments. If your child is one of these students, your school principal will contact you in this regard.

The information provided here is intended only as a very brief overview. More detailed information is provided throughout the year as the testing window for each assessment approaches.
