<b>Able to identify and discuss the days of the week and months of the year using basic words in Spanish</b>	<b>7.1.NM.A.5</b> Demonstrate comprehension of brief oral and written messages.*	Sing or recite the days of the week and months of the year in Spanish.
<b>Able to identify and discuss holidays and weather in Spanish using basic words</b>	<b>7.1.NM.A.5</b> Demonstrate comprehension of brief oral and written messages.*	Tell a weather forecast in Spanish and understand and describe holidays such as Dia de los Muertos, or Day of the Dead.
<b>Develop insights into other cultures, as well as their own</b>	<b>7.1.NM.A.3</b> Recognize a few common gestures and cultural practices associated with the target culture.*	Recognize certain differences between ours and other cultures.

\* This standard represents one that applies to the “Novice-Mid Language Learner,” a designation used to help structure New Jersey’s World Language Standards. As such, these are standards that reflect an expectation of mastery after several years of instruction in Spanish. We include them here to make clear how the skills being taught tie to long-term instructional goals rather than single year goals.
