



Beginning the first day of school, all students will no longer use the old six digit pin number for the cafeteria point of sale system. Students will be assigned a new unique ***four-digit*** pin number that will remain with them through all of their years in the Haddon Township School District. This will make it easier for students to move quickly through the lunch line and allow for more time to enjoy their food!

HOW?

On Friday September 9th students will be given a card with their new ***four-digit*** pin number. They will use this card to make lunch purchases as a reminder of their ***four-digit*** pin number. The card will then be left with the cafeteria cashier and returned to the student the following day. This process will continue until the student memorizes their pin number. The cashiers can also access your child's account by last name, giving students time to memorize their number.
